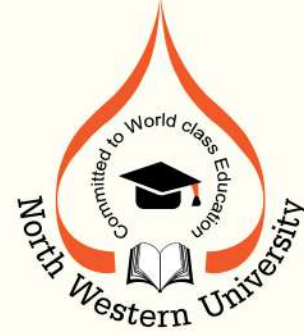

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree in Medical, Nursing, Dental sciences or Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 2 years work experience in related field.
- For those entering with a baccalaureate degree, a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.5 (in a scale of 4.0), or at least a second class in baccalaureate program with one year's experience working in the health or development sectors.
- Pass a placement test for MPH program in NWU. Applicants for admission will be evaluated on the basis of their academic records and on the results of the placement test and oral interview.

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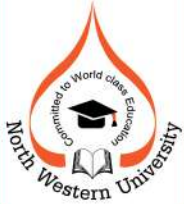
