Prof. Sheikh Md. Enayetul Babar, PhD joined North Western University (NWU) as its Vice Chancellor on February 1, 2024. He was appointed for a four year term by the president of Bangladesh and Chancellor of the university. Prior to joining the position, he was a professor at the Biotechnology and Genetic Engineering Discipline (BGE) Khulna University. He had been in teaching in Biotechnology and Genetic Engineering Discipline, Khulna University since 1996. Prof. Babar obtained his PhD in Biomolecular Science from University of Science and Technology (UST), and Korea Institute of Science and Technology (KIST), South Korea in 2008.

Prof. Babar did Master of Engineering in Bioprocess Technology from Asian Institute of Technology (AIT) Thailand in 2001 and B.Sc. in Chemical Engineering from the Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (BUET) in 1995. He is engaged in multidimensional research, which includes Internal Quality Assurance in Tertiary Education, Bioreactor Design, Biofuel, Systems Biology, Bioanalytical Method Development, Biological/Biochemical Waste Management, and Process Optimization. A total of 21 journal articles by prof. Babar have been published in reputed national and international journals.

Upgradation of Civil Engineering Laboratory, NWU

North Western University (NWU) upgraded the laboratories of the Civil Engineering Department in Fall 2023. New types of equipment have been added to upgrade five laboratories, namely the Transportation Engineering Laboratory, Practical Surveying Laboratory, Geotechnical Engineering Laboratory, Environmental Engineering Laboratory, and Engineering Materials Laboratory. The creation of the Civil Engineering laboratories has had a profound impact on the success of the department in allowing opportunities for students

like Plain Table, Engineering Chains, tapes, levels, prismatic compass, and theodolites, and the new addition is a modern high-quality Total Station (Kolida) (KTS 442UT) for accurate and digital levels. Undergraduate students use the laboratory as an integral part of their surveying coursework and obtain any topographic information that can help their design projects, such as highway design and land development. Moreover, students learn techniques about how to gather field data and use them for preparing maps with



and faculty members to explore more extensive and comprehensive research and teaching activities.

Transportation Engineering Laboratory has been providing testing and design contributions since its inception in diverse areas including quality control and testing of highway materials, geometric design of highways, structural design of pavements, field investigations of highway projects, traffic control and management, accident analysis and safety measures, feasibility study of transport projects, preparation and evaluation of contractual documents. This is just one of the impressive new laboratory additions where the main equipment is available for the identification and determination of the properties of bituminous binders and asphalt mixtures. The newly added equipment is the penetration testing machine, loss on heating test apparatus, softening point test apparatus, impact testing apparatus, ACV testing apparatus, flakiness and elongation index testing apparatus, CBR testing apparatus, Marshall method of mix design apparatus, ovens of different kinds, etc.

Practical Surveying Laboratory of the Department of Civil Engineering, North Western University, continued to provide service of equipment maintenance and production of special surveying accessories in support of teaching & learning and research activities. It contains many conventional and modern surveying instruments both traditional and modern instruments on a week-long field's survey program. Geotechnical Engineering Laboratory of North Western University is equipped with all modern types of machinery required for advanced research and consultancy services. The primary aim of the Geotechnical Lab is to advance the theory and application of soil mechanics. This laboratory provides both students and faculty members with an excellent opportunity to conduct quality research. Along with other basic tests on soil, the newly attached equipment is Sand Cone Apparatus, Unconfined Compression Testing Machine, and Direct Shear Testing Machine.

Environmental Engineering Laboratory of North Western University has always been a resourceful place for conducting advanced research and consultancy. The new addition to the lab is Multimeter (HANNA, HI-9813-61) (pH, TDS, EC), Turbidity meter (HANNA-TU-2016), Dissolved Oxygen Meter (LUTRON, DO-5509) and UV-VIS Spectrophotometer (FAITHFUL).

Engineering Materials Laboratory of North Western University has almost all kinds of apparatus that provide excellent support for material testing and consultancy. The newly added Analog Scale (BUET Calibrated) in the Compression Testing Machine has enhanced the accuracy and appropriateness of the laboratory.




NWU Pitha Utshob-1430


